The annual reports are designed to monitor and evaluate the implementation of the City's Comprehensive Plan. The annual report is meant to be a gauge to measure the extent to which the Plan is able to effectively guide land use decisions. It includes sets of quantitative data indicating the general direction in which the community is heading, as well as a summary of City projects and programs that are implementing the Plan's objectives. The annual report also evaluates the progress made in achieving the Plan's objectives. The general public can utilize the annual report's current data and maps to determine if the City is making strides towards the long range vision spelled out in the Comprehensive Plan.
